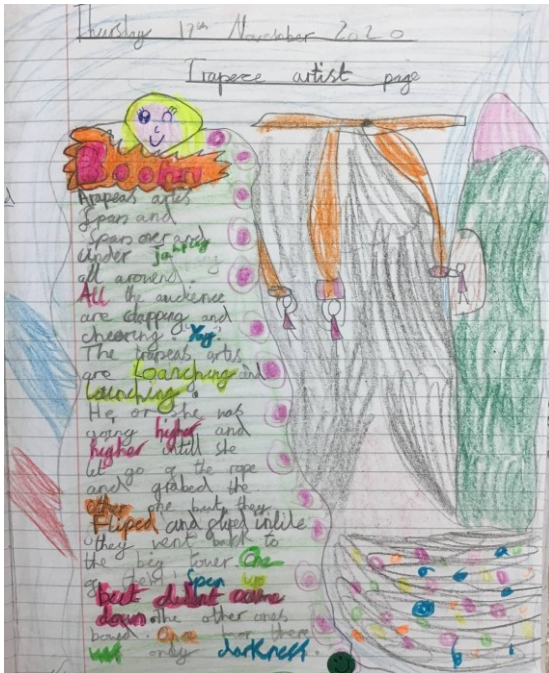

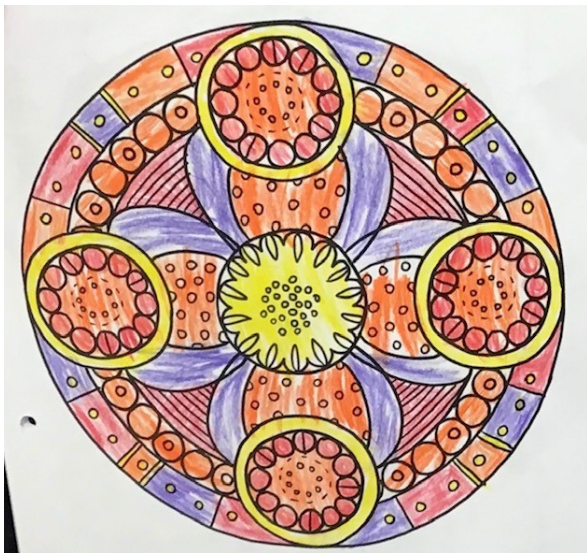
Isabella 3R

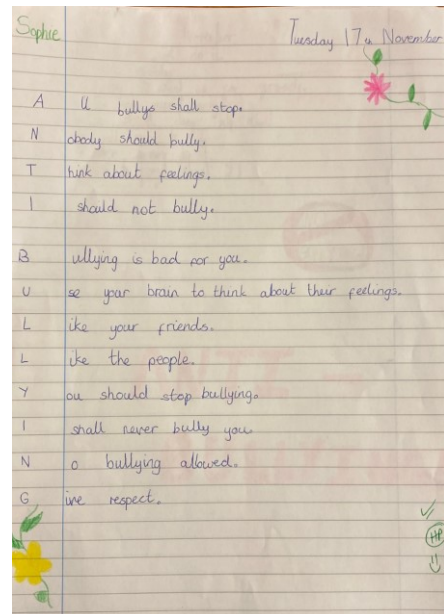
Filip 4D

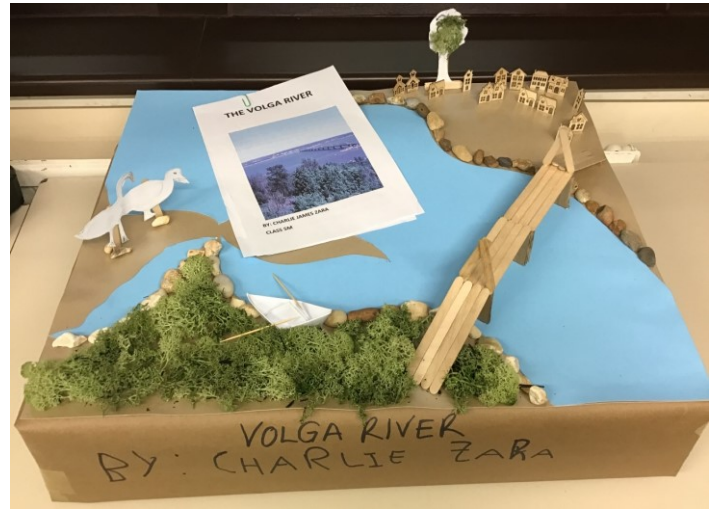
Aleena 5D

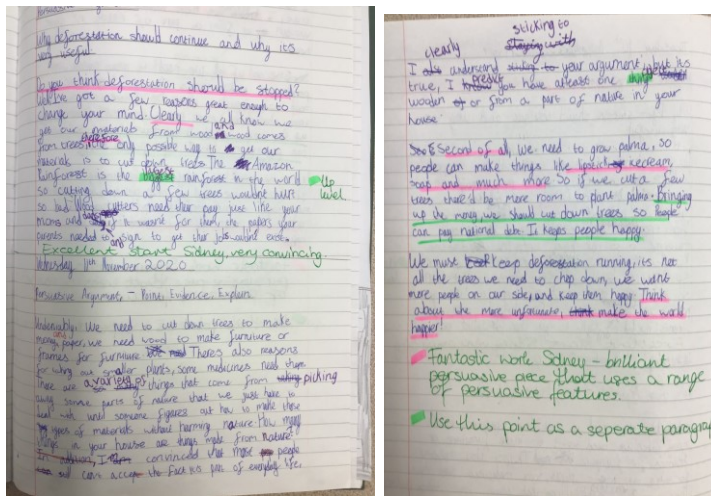
Charlie 5M
